The journey of nineteen years with ups and downs has been a huge learning experience and quite satisfying to facilitate the needy to work on different activities, access to services etc.

This year 2018 -19 protecting children of mica mining area was in focus and was quite satisfactory for the organisation to work simultaneously for the children and their parents. The noble project is protecting the children to avoid mica mining , taking education and helping their parents in creating alternate livelihood opportunity in the area, quite satisfying the achievement was , from 5 to 55% attendance in AWC, 141 children enrolled in mainstream school and Rs. 6,50,550 is the profit amount from income generating activities of the parents is quite satisfying. The most INNOVATIVE initiative under this project was BAL MANCH which is so effective in creating child exploitation free villages is been initiated in which magically the children got enrolled in the school, AWC.

This year 2018 -19 , the organization has been focussing on child right supported by CRY on UN convention on the right of children to provide survival, development, protection and participation rights of the children with concentration on improving health, nutrition and education of the children. Model Aanganwadi has been the focus to create a prototype to be replicated, the model was so successful that the rural children felt first time education at par with the private schools at their village. The PRAYAS program was another key work in which it is envisaged to enrol all children 6 to 18 years of age group , there were several innovative activities were done to ensure 100% enrolment and also been ensured of hundred percent continuity of the children in the school after enrolment.

CHILDLINE 1098 was buzzword in 2018- 19 among the community which largely helped the children and the parents to protect their children, quite satisfactory the year establishing the centre as part and partial of the community and the organisation.

This year also the organisation worked for mica children and child marriage was very satisfactory as these works given eternal satisfaction as this become a major area of discussion among the society which resulted in drastic change among the society towards education of the children and stopping child marriage

The regular work on farm and non-farm based Livelihood were continued in 2018-19 for the poors, agriculture work , livestock specially goat rearing and fishery with scientific management system which enhances yield , increases the heard size has resulted a good result in enhancing the income of the poors . The work for mica children parents and creating entrepreneurship among the young have created opportunity for the poors in their own land and have provided additional income which impacted their life as this become another source of income apart from labour , migration etc. Scientific goat rearing.

A set of villages benefits from our health, education and skill development programs in Koderma. During these years, we have developed a rapport with the beneficiaries in these villages. We need to convert the goodwill for proactive engagement of these beneficiaries in issues such as Water harvesting(Jal Sanchay) , sanitation, hygiene, work for the PVTGs etc.. These initiatives will be a major step towards creating successful and replicable models for development and growth

Community mental health programme has been part of the organisation program as this is charity towards most vulnerable who even can't help themselves due to their mental illness..

Fortunately expressing my views that the organization has always been supported by young and dedicated work force who always aspires to reach our set vision and mission.

I express my heartfelt gratitude towards our supporting agencies local individual persons and well wishers without whose support; it was not possible to reach this small destination. 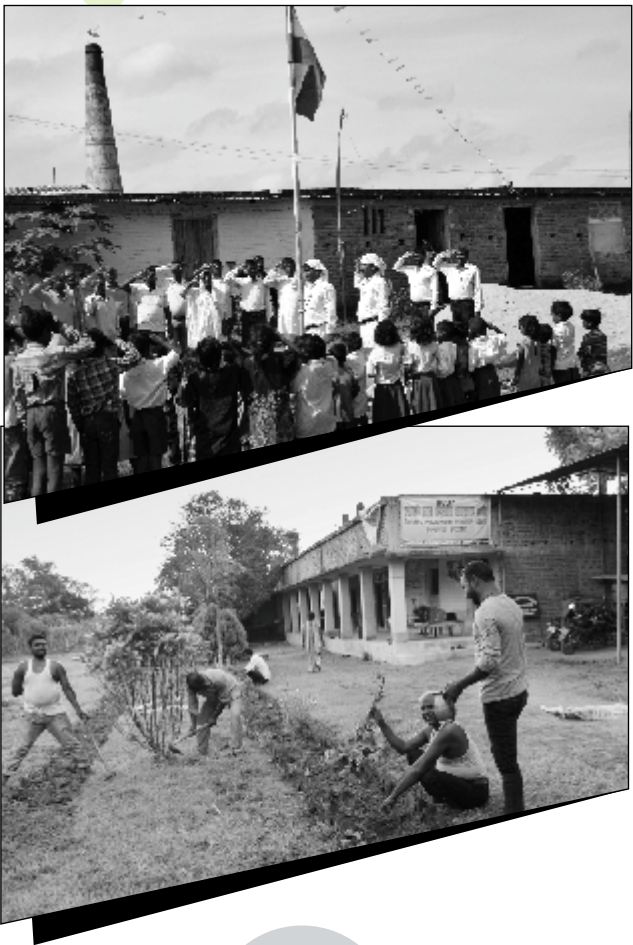

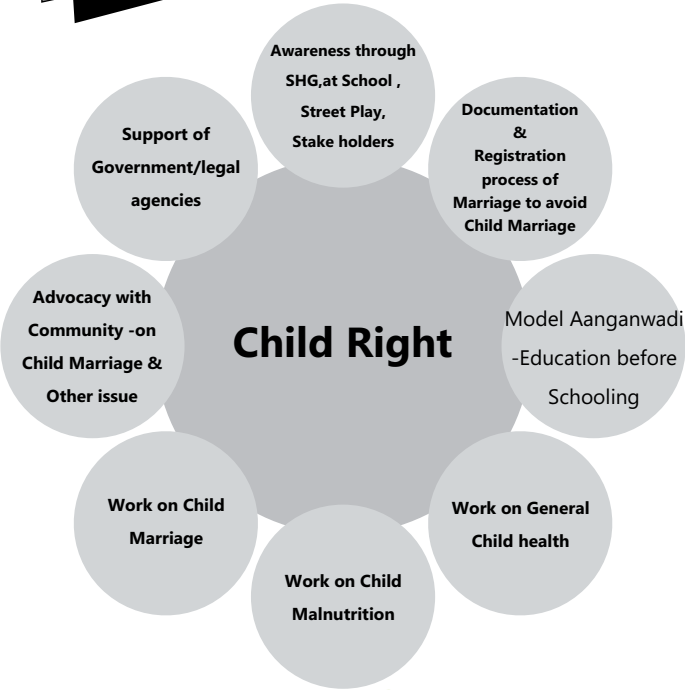
**Ashram** *Development begins with.....*

The organization has already formed health committees, strengthening and regular execution of school management committees (SMC) meeting,organizing health camps for the children. the of the community and to the stake holders like Mata Samiti, ANM ,Sahayika of ICDS centre, Village Health Committee(VHC),Rogi Kalyan Samiti, Hospital Management committee, Sahiya, doctors and to Village Education Committee ,school teachers. The organization has focussed on mobilization of the top officials at district level for better and proper implementation of the government run programs in the block.

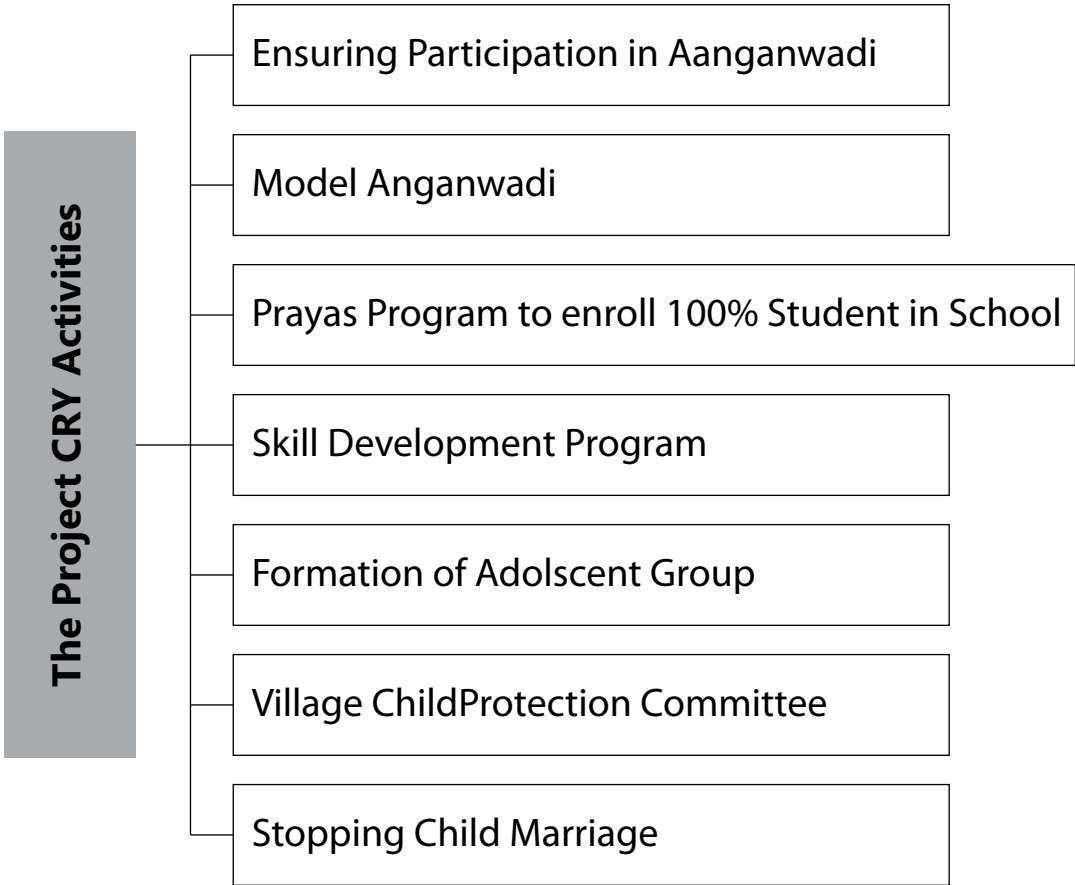

The Project CRY-On Child Protection

The organisation is Implementing CRY project for child right, awareness is one of the core strategy of the project to provide child right to the child, RJSS has done innovation to aware the community, this is a drive mode with mission approach to understand each and every section of the society to inculcate the concept so that it become sustainable practice, become part and partial to practice such rights. To educate the women SHG was taken as platform, to educate the youths, Youths committee was selected , to aware the children, school was selected , to educate the Govt. Panchayat Raj , workshop , presence in health committee meetings , Panchayat Raj meeting was platform to aware the people.



Ensuring Participation in Aanganwadi

Aanganwadi is a rural child care centre which is established to combat child hunger and malnutrition. Aanganwadi centre provides basic health care in a village which includes nutrition education and supplementation, as well as pre-school activities for 3 to 6 years of age.

The project has played vital role in ensuring participation of the children, providing quality education at centre and has worked to mainstream in formal schooling to the next level. The organisation has tried to work on each of the objective of the Aanganwadi , has worked to ensure quality food , nutrition , helped in creating environment where children 's physical and mental state could grow.

Meri Patrika was used as tool to monitor the children their growth in targeted 200 children of 19 Aanganwadi Centre at Satganwan block of Koderma district, 36 children were found eligible for formal education in class 1st.

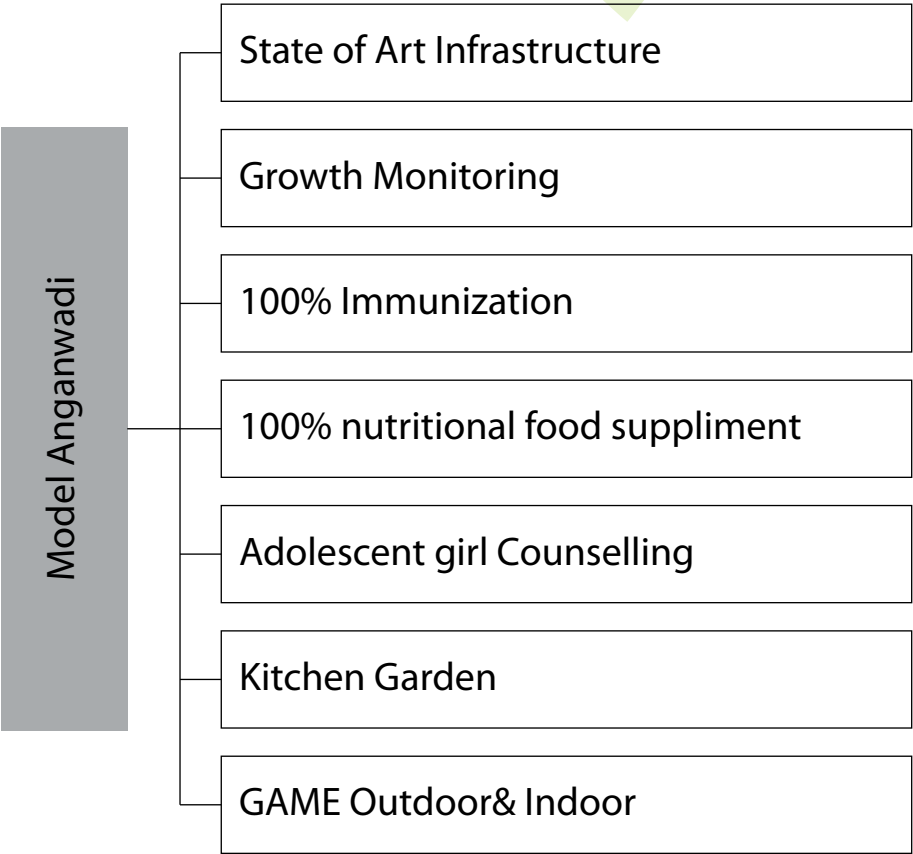

Children's parliament (Bal Sansad), it is just portrayal of our Republic of India PARLIAMENT(SANSAD). This is an innovation implemented under CRY project. The entire concept of SANSAD is been translated for children, here students of the school are in opposition and one group is running the country (School) (Satta Paksh), there is PRIMINISTER , FINANCE MINISTRY, WATER MINISTER , EDUCATION MINISTER , ENVIRONMENT MINISTER , CLEANLINESS MINISTER etc. Once in a month the whole ministry with opposition sits , work done is been evaluated , opposition raises their hand for non realization of work, ministers are been asked to clarify . The whole team take decisions in presence of Principal to solve the problems, and appreciated if work is been done. This innovation has been wonderful experience for the children and helpful in mitigating the problems of Government school.

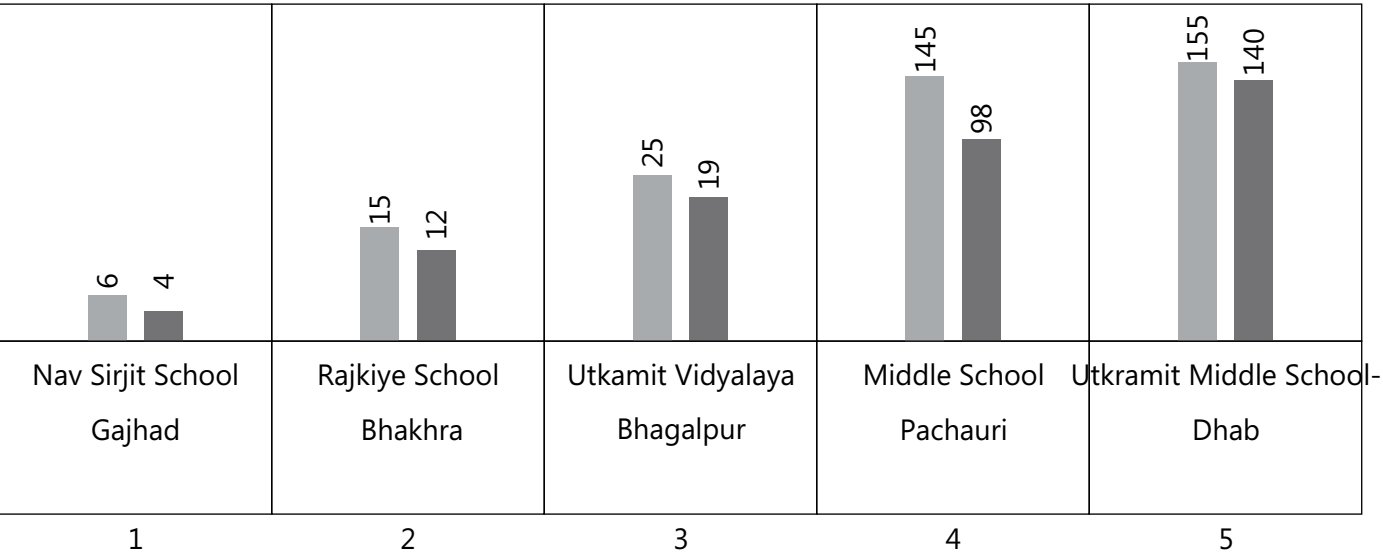

## Adolescent Group- A change Ambassador

Kishori Mandal is a platform provides Kishoris a confidence , decision power to take decision s for them selves , the platform has been acting a big role in doing changes and adopting the hellthy practices like sanitation , taking care of their general health , getting regular medication needed for them and are able to speak openly on child marriage on the geound of their health.

The organisation has been working on child protection and rights since 1999. Adolescent group have been formed to work collectively to combat the problems of and take collective decision to take rights and entitlement for the children. Adolescent group have been regularly doing monthly meeting in which they discuss various issue such as illiteracy, child marriage, child labour, drop out of students, out of school children and strategy have been devised and worked on all such issues. The group have been successful in mobilizing the parents, children , attendance at school have increased, dropout rate has also been decreased and out of school children have been enrolled. The children and the parents have learned not to marry their children in early age.

## Village Child Protection Committee

Child protection committee is a village level committee to protect the different rights of the children by coordinating different organisation so that their right to survival, development, protection and participation rights could be safeguarded. The committee is run by Aanganwadi Sevika comprises of PRI members , SHG representatives , school committee members , NGOs representatives and Gram Pradhan of the villages/

The non-functional committee could rarely be protecting the child rights so the organisation is working on making it functional, made the members active enough so that the right of the children could be ensured. The committee is guided by the Govt. regulation under Child protection and there are district and block level committees too to guide the village level committees.

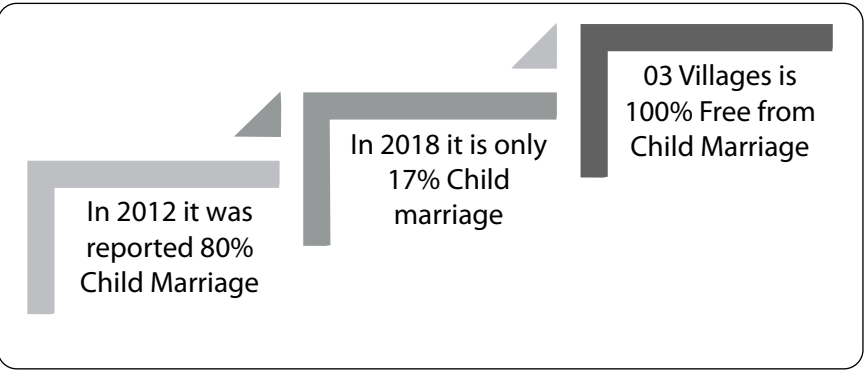
The organisation is working to protect the child right so strengthening of the committee is core to ensure all protection to the children.

The organisation have trained 105 Aanganwadi Sevikas on child protection committee , the training was to ensure committee meeting , updating of records and tracking the development of children so that they may be protected from any of the social evil . 19 Aanganwadi centres have been given concentration and 5 model Aanganwadi is also been created in which positive result towards child protection is been observed, meetings are regularly been conducted.



## Stopping Child Marriage

The organisation is working on eliminating child marriage since 2012. The drastic change in child marriage is drop out from 80% to only 17% from 2012 to 2018. The organisation has done strong planning to combat the practice, the awareness drive through street play, awareness in schools, discussions with the intellectuals, Panchayat representatives and advocacy for the same with the religious Guru, intellectuals to made the system strong enough within the society so that the natural system could be built to avoid early marriage thus to check the death of the women for the larger benefit of the community, humanity. The organisation is quite successful in understanding the community and a system is built in which proper documentation system is adopted, community are taking it seriously to Advocacy with Community -on Child Marriage & Other issue .



The effort towards child marriage beard a fruit , 3 Villages namely Mananpur , Bhagalpur and Bhakhra is 100% free from child marriage .There are 1275 family members who have taken oath not to do child marriage , adolescent group has played key role in eliminating this practice , the organisation is relentlessly doing awareness , workshops at block and district level.

### CHILD MARRIAGE FREE KODERMA - CHILD EXPLOITATION FREE KODERMA & BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO

The organisation is fetching support of the Government and legal agencies to intensify the drive to expedite the effort in minimising child marriage, children to provide survival, development, protection and participation rights with concentration on improving health, nutrition and education of the children.

The intensive drive to protect child marriage , child exploitation and education for girl child was taken by the organisation with OATH TAKING EVENT of 575 adolescent and 375 parents with the support of district administartion , CRY Kolkata, Childline Satganwan and TDH . The event was to aware through moving district and concluded in the district collectoriate in which the DC Mr.Bhuwnesh Pratap Singh and other officials addressed the community members , adolescent and their children on protecting child right , stopping child marriage and support in eliminating child exploitation.

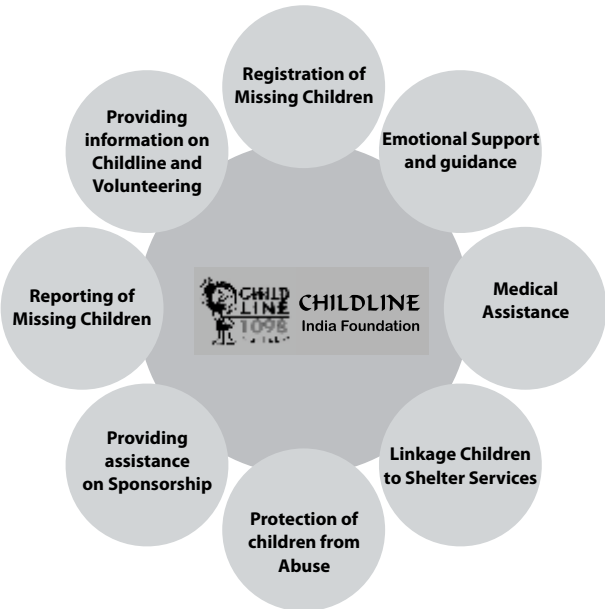
The Project -Childline



In 1996, CHILDLINE India Foundation (CIF) launched CHILDLINE, the country's first toll-free tele-helpline for street children in distress. As of March 2015, total of 36 Million calls since inception have been serviced by CHILDLINE service and operates in 473cities/districts in 35 States/UTs through its network of over 887 partner organisations across India. Rashtriya Jharkhand Seva Sansthan (RJSS) is proud to be part of the movement.

The movement of child protection with the help of CRY is part of RJSS, the organisation does several activities in executing the plan, it starts from regular brainstorming session with different eminent personality, similar event was organised on 4th Oct 2108 with Govt. officials, stake holders and ChildLine officials The ChildLine conducts several innovative activities like

ChildLine Friendship Program: This usually happens on childrens day on 14thNovember of every in which village teacher , Aanganwadi sewika , Ward members , and others to bind band to mark the protection of child in the area .So there were several such programs organised in different schools , police station and to aware the people on child right which was appreciated by all .

## CHILDLINE THROUGH ADMINISTRATION

24 hours service for the children is child line is been established in Ashram premises at Bhakra is free service for all needy. The service 1098 is available for any one feeling problem, unsafe, the organisation reaches to the children if call is for any help, the organisation is working under ChildLine India foundation. The awareness drive is been done for ChildLine so that the people may take advantage of the services.

There are various awareness subject is been taken like child abuse and violence, trafficking , child marriage, problem for street children , missing children , children without parents , child sexual abuse , child labour, orphans care , orphanage centre CWC shelter home etc. The organisation has been organising meeting with school, Police station (Thana), panchayat representatives, community members.

- ❑ Capacity building is been executed for child line
- ❑ The child line started with the meeting with the DC ,renowned person of the didistrict , peoples representatives , police administration , district child committee members.
- ❑ Coordination with police station , health department , BDO office is been established to work collectively for the purpose .
- ❑ Lets go to School: A campaign is been organised to Shool Chalen in the schools so that the left out of school children may be inducted in the school, approx. 1000 children were part of the campaign.
- ❑ Swachta Campaign: The childline lead the swachta abhiyan in 15 schools in which 685 were aware on it , consequently the school premises is now found clean, the bathroom , toilets are becoming every day clean .
- ❑ Awareness campaign through Temple: The awareness campaign is also been organised through Temple so that the child line get more popular and the service may be taken by all the villagers.

The campaign under ChildLine is expedited with different program like organising workshop, friendship program, awareness etc. In this line a meeting was organised with BDO of Satganwan to protect child right , a special focus was given on child marriage and child labour prevalent in the society which must be checked , the meeting has another dignitaries too like Mr.Bhuneshwar Oraon- Zila Parishad

### Awareness Campaign through Temple

On the occasion of Mahashivratri, the organisation aware the believers to protect the child right in the block , this was organised under the guidance and mentorship of Baidnath Oraon - Zila Parishad and other dignitaries.

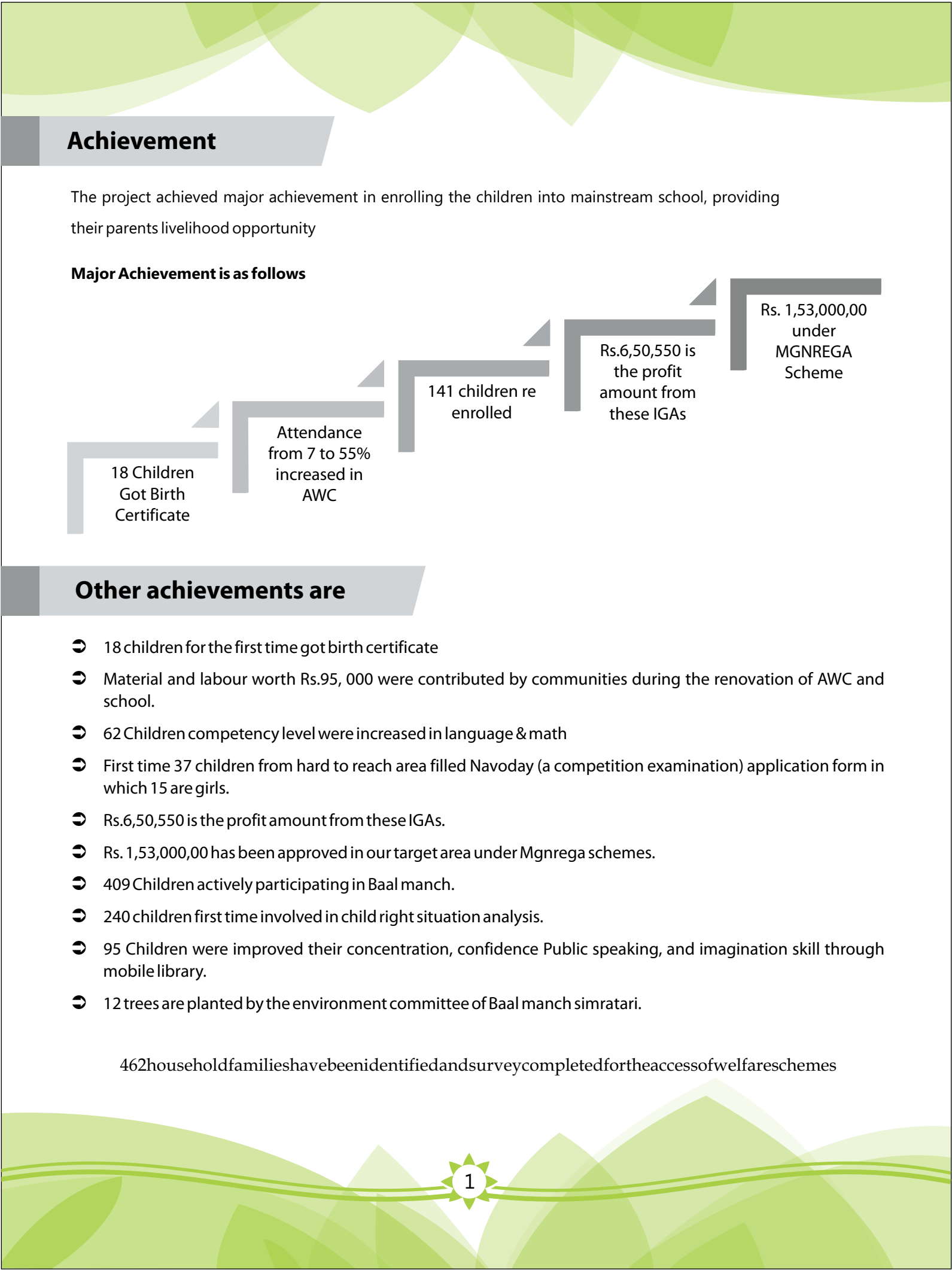
CHILD PROTECTION IN MICA

MINING AREAS OF JHARKHAND

The organisation is running child protection scheme for the Mica children, the noble project is protecting the children to avoid mica mining , taking education and helping their parents in creating alternate livelihood opportunity in the area.

Following are the major objective of the project

- All children between 3-6 years of age complete Early Childhood Education and school preparedness.4
- 80% of children between 6-14 years of age achieve grade appropriate academic and co-curricular competency
- Children at the village/Block/District level acts as Change Agents in 100% villages.
- Village level Institutions (Primary/SMC/VLCPC/SHGs/VHSNCs etc.) actively addressing child right issues.
- Livelihoods of parents are strengthened to address the needs of the children.
- Community members are sensitized on rights of the children and access maximum welfare schemes of the government.





## Safe Mobility

The A project through Jharkhand Anti Trafficking Network- JATAN , OAK Foundation and Safe organisation is working on safe mobility while migrating in different part of the district , blocks or other part of the country.

Migration of poor is always unsafe and risky too as they work under vulnerable condition as this is unorganised sector. Food insecurity in the lean period, unavailability of work at villages , unskilled labor are forced to migrate to earn to secure food , checking migration in the state is a massive task of government to provide employment at villages, blocks or at city so that the poor people may not migrate and should stay in state itself. The development graph of the poor is abysmal, the poor doesn't get sufficient job and other opportunity due to its rain fed economy so they are force to move.

Migration for someone is very lucrative if getting good job, satisfactory, with incentive, safe as is been done by several migrating to other countries and in good places in country itself.

Understanding the situation, the organisation is working towards safe and meaningful mobilityof the poor. The organisation has been successfully mobilizing, doing awareness drive on safe mobility concept. It has been great success after putting lot of effort in sensitizing the community, Government, NGOs, coordinating with Government department on it sustainability in the state also.

Since last 6 years the organisation is working on the issue in different part of the district Koderma . There are 2 Panchayat , 12 villages in which organisation is working through migration group formation in which above 18 are been aware on safe mobility . The organisation is working on creating other livelihood opportunity for the migrating person like have provided 70 Red card , 125 people have been converged with different Govt. schemes

## Holistic Development In Awc

### Rights and Advocacy

#### Advocacy and Entitlement

Advocacy is to influence and lobby duty bearers so that they meet their obligations .Rights are often violated through a combination of complex processes, from the levels of family and community to those of national, regional and international .Based on evidence from experience and commitment to giving people, children a voice, We can play a key role in supporting people/children, their families and communities to claim their rights. By doing effective advocacy, we can bring about key changes in policy, legislation and practice that will have a lasting impact on people/children's lives.

Advocacy for the rights and entitlement has been the need of the poor rural population. The organization has been relentlessly working on it and doing awareness campaign, meeting with community members and stake holders meeting, finding issues and putting before government officials for proper implementation of Government scheme and on policy level intervention on scheme like NREGS, RTI 2005, Disabled Act 1995 and on different Government welfare schemes.

#### Lok Samiti:

RJSS has been doing advocacy and lobbying for the right and entitlement of the people under Lok Samiti.

Lok Samiti is a network of different NGOs in different part of the state which fight against corruption, discrimination, callousness prevailed in the society and for the rights of the people. RJSS has been working since 1997 and taken up some urgent issues of the region such as poverty, right and entitlement for the people, implementation of government schemes, right to information act, prohibition of dowry & elimination of female & foeticide etc.

In the year 2018-19, a dedicated meeting was organised, the discussion on rights and entitlement was.

## Women Empowerment and Institution of Women

The organisation has been working since last 18 years on women empowerment. Women empowerment in RJSS refers to increasing the economic, political, social, educational, gender, or spiritual strength. The organisation has been working with members of SHG to provide economic freedom through bank linkages and creating women entrepreneur through skill development programs, it has been building them as self- reliant, and independent entrepreneur. Educating the girl child has been focus and the organization has expertise in it, provided education to hundreds of poor children from remote area of the state. RJSS is providing poor women leading their group, their business, a platform to gather and owning their own dais to convey the world their concern and share their happiness of empowerment. RJSS has always been putting its best effort to empower them financially, socially, politically and to instil leadership quality, to strongly stand on their own, can run their livelihood and above all can boldly face the situation of molestation, abuse prevailed in the society.

## Community Institution: Women Self Help Group

The organisation has been working in getting a common platform of discussion, trying to making economically sustainable , raising their voice to get the empowered .Poverty alleviation of the poor has been major challenge to the country, the strong institution of the poor in form women SHGs and federation has played vital role in eliminating poverty. The poor members of the SHG managed to come out of clutches of money lenders, have access of easy and affordable access of loan amount from their small saving. The women under RJSS guidance have formed SHGs in the area coming together on a self-selection basis for sharing their common concerns, pool their own resources (both financial and non-financial) and work together for their personal, social, economic and political development.”

To improve the socio economic status of the women, R.J.S.S. has been actively involved on S.H.G. Bank linkage and promoting internal lending within the group. The SHGs have now empowered and got freedom from the clutches of money lenders.

## SHG STATISTICS

The organisation in Satganwan alone promoted 275 SHGs in 120 villages and total of 294 SHGs in the district working in Koderma block, Jaynagar and Markacho, the groups formed for doing small business in their area, the groups has been linked to various income generation activities like Dairy, Vegetable cultivation, Agriculture goatry, Bangles shop, Pattal Plate making etc. The livelihood activities has raised their income level and helped to improve their social and economic status in the society.

## Livelihood

### Sustainable Agriculture development Program

RJSS has been working in the Agriculture and horticulture to provide sustainable livelihood opportunity round the year, promotion of horticulture is one the option which has no maintenance if up bring rightly in initial phase. The organization has promoted fruit plants, timber plants, papaya for the poor farmers.

### Vegetable growing under BFW and NBJK

RJSS has promoted cash crop which can meet their daily expenses too. The organization believes in promoting multiple livelihood activities with the poor villagers so that failure of one livelihood activity can resist shock, can a poor farmer withstand and face any loss, trouble and can easily run their family. The organization promoted vegetable growing with more than 70 farmers; the farmers are doing vegetable cultivation along with paddy, selling in the local market and have comfortable income to run their family.

## Training

RJSS has been working towards empowerment of the women, encompassing social, economic, political growth. RJSS effort to provide economic independence through providing skill development of the women.

The organization has been working since long to provide different skill training to the women. This year 2018-19 RJSS has provided skill based training on sewing, flower pots, Lac Chauri, Bamboo craft, Sewing and Cutting, embroidery, training on agriculture, animal husbandry like goatry, piggery.

### NTFP based skill development Training:

Skill development on Lac, Production, Processing and making produce of Lac:

RJSS in Khunti district among 40 Lac grower women imparted training in 15 villages on Lac production, processing, and finally making produce out of lac. A comprehensive training was provided by skilled trainer in the district for lac produce such as bangles, pots, etc. Lac Chauri is prepared after melting the lac, is a material used in production of final produce of Lac. Producing Lac CHAURI requires different skill so training on Chauri was also provided before making its final product.

## Non-Farm

### Sewing and Cutting Training

RJSS has a good experience in promoting sewing and cutting based entrepreneurship to women since a long, it has always been providing training to rural SHG women, this year too 264 women through 8 centres have been provided training.

## FARM Based Training

### Training on Vegetable cultivation

Agriculture is the main source of livelihood of the rural population of Jharkhand, erratic rainfall does not allow farmer to do round the year cropping in their field, although small amount of water at dug well always attract farmer to do some crop. RJSS has took advantage and provided training on vegetable growing who can manage water round the year. Training and exposure visit with the trained trainers provided good result. There were 70 farmers who have taken training at Ashram promised and are doing vegetable cultivation, they have started earning also.

RJSS has been providing training to the rural youths since long to get them economically self-sustainable. The organization has focussed not only on farm but on non- farm activities too.

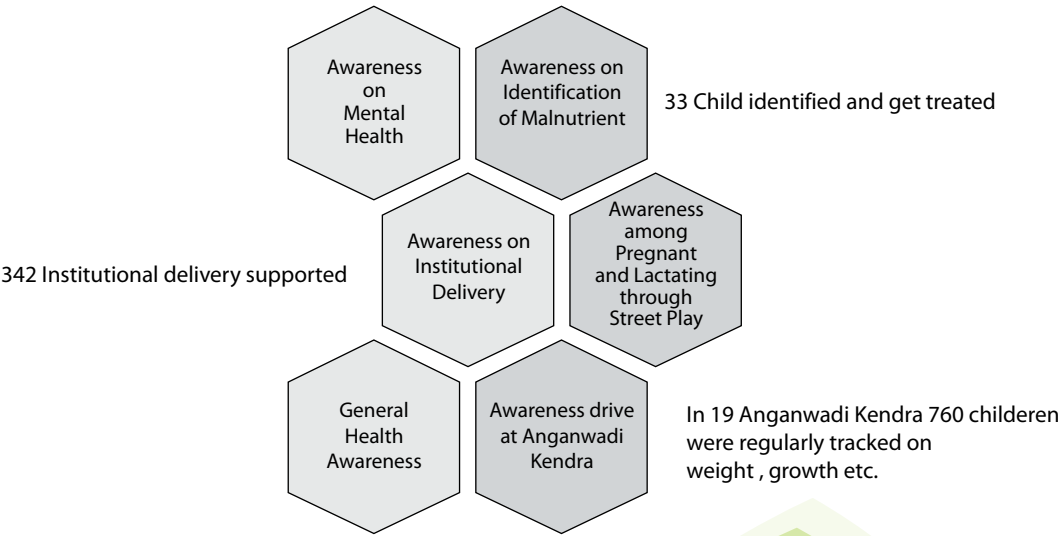

## Health

Public Health has been in prime focus of of the organisation . The organisation has been working for health improvement of the community focusing on both in demand and supply side , the community is been mobilized, aware on the health issues, capacity built and on demand side the Govt. agencies are been mobilised to provide the better services. Organizing General health camps in different villages, Eye Health camps , working on maternal and child health, reproductive and child health and community mental health are such area on improving health of the society where the organization is regularly intervening. Poor health status of the community is key factor of the poverty, the poor are unaware of preventive cure rather reluctantly go for curing while in trouble. The poor people are always get trapped into the problems of health hazard, the consequence is that it make them poor. The organization has taken initiative of organizing health camps, converge with the Govt. existing facilities available in sub centre, PHC, CHS, immunization, taking benefits of AWC, institutional delivery.

### Community Mental Health Program

The organisation has been working for Mentally ill peoplesince last 12 years . Mental ill people are vulnerable section of the society ,among them, women are the worst vulnerable, they are always seen in the platform, bus stand and in the roads moving around, are not been thought of by any segment of the society. The program is been implemented in Satganwan block of Koderma district and Nawada district of Bihar state. The program has been quite successful in providing health to the mentally ill people whom even the family members left them considering they wouldn't be ever cured.

Under the Community mental health program mentally disabled person are identified by the supervisors, mobilized the community for their treatment, taken for free treatment to Nawada district or Ranchi Mental hospital, given medicine and finally closely monitored to timely administer the medicine. This year 325 (Three hundred and twenty five) patients had been identified, 12 patients have been formalised into their family and 25 are been regularly under treatment.

### ENVIROMENT

Saving from environmental hazards has been mandate of the organisation. The organisation has been primarily focussing on deforestation in different district of the state.

**HARIT CHETNA:** An innovative initiative of saving the environment has been quite successful in saving the forest, the beauty of the initiative is to aware and convince those people who used to cut the forest to save the forest, now they are part of the intervention is now voluntarily involved in saving the forest and in regeneration to protect the environment.

An innovative initiative of Raksha Bandhan to bind ribbon on the trees understanding that this is a knot between the sister and the brother and the brother will never destroy the relationship in lifetime as is in Raksha Bandhan. The idea is to bind the community towards spirituality to save the trees. There were several activities under the umbrella of saving the forest. Community mobilization was major activity which was also been done in mission mode and in different fashion so that the people may really understand the need of protecting the forest. The villagers, volunteers and other stake holders like forest committee were given exhaustive training on the issue and created a big team to protect the forest.

Organization has been working on Harit chetna focussing five areas of intervention to execute this innovative initiative

- I. Awareness building in campaign mode: This year Organization has done awareness building program in 715 villages in different districts of the state i.e Koderma, Lohardaga, Giridih, Khunti, Gumla, Chatra, Ramgarh and Ranchi.
- ii. Street Play: Street play has been organized ,taking school children
- iii. Strengthening Forest Committee: RJSS has strengthened 680 forest committee in which 12180 members have been mobilised in Koderma, Lohardaga, Giridih, Khunti, Gumla, Chatra, Ramgarh and Ranchi.
- iv. Forest regeneration:The fast reduction of forest plant is the result of cutting trees but in some ways it could also be compensated by plantation of the trees also. The organization has taken this issue very seriously and by the help of the community, RJSS in the district Koderma and Gumla planted 8200 fruit plants

v. Forest Raksha Bandhan Program (A specialized intervention to protect forest)

An innovative initiative of Raksha Bandhan to bind ribbon on the trees not to cut the tree has been initiated in 1995 at Tatijhariya village of Hazaribagh district . RJSS in the year 2004 has adopted this as major program to save the tree to save the environment. Since the adoption of the program as core program, it has done worked for more than 1200 hectare of forest area in Koderma, Chatra, Gumla,Giridih, Simdega ,Ranchi,Hazaribagh ,Koderma , Lohardaga , West Singbhum and in east Singbhum.

There are various innovations have also been introduced to save the forest under Raksha Bandhan Program like Pad Yatra, Cycle Yatra, Motorcycle Yatra, Bhikchatan and meeting with the villagers. It has great impact on saving the forest by the villagers.

Year 2000 is always been remembered and frequently referred in the achievement of the organisation, the year was marked as to start working for most vulnerable community who speaks neither Hindi nor local language but speaks Asuri is Birhor community are under particularly vulnerable group. The communities' pitiful condition had forced to start working for the group.

Saving the primitive tribe especially the Birhore community is one of the focused agenda of the Government. The survival of the community is on stake because of huge deforestation and climate change. The community used to live in the forest and their livelihood was dependent on the forest produce, now they are unable to cope the concrete world. The organization has been working to mainstream with the society.

The work for them focusing on awareness on child education, health, sanitation, providing Food Security. The visit to the area is alike visiting to the home of every staffs , volunteers , a dedicated work with empathy to the people has given some success to get their child into mainstream of the society , there are examples which we feel pride some time .

**Work on Safe Migration, Child right for child working in Mica Ensuring Safe Migration of Women**

## Child Labour free Village

### A Village Without exploitation to the children – Teredez Home Nitherland

Koderma is known for its mica mining , largely the people were involved in the mining work, among them mostly the labours were dependent on the mining and become part of the activity since a long and couldn't think beyond it .The sudden crashing of mica market get the people vulnerable and the children were the worst affected from the economic changes in the district, children were not able to take education rather compelled to work as child labour in any of the work like in brick koln , stone work,, hotel etc and moreover the child marriage become a compulsion for the parents.

The organisation with the support of Teredez Home Netherlands working for the vulnerable society , the identification is been done in first phase and massive awareness , group formation, committies formation is been done for education , Health , environment ,entertainment and security committee is been formed to make child labour free village .

The pain of the mica minning family is immense with the entire people living near to them and being social worker the RJSS family have eager to get them out from the trap and has vision to see the members of family happy with education , child labour free village , non exploitation of girl child , no child marriage as the situation is pitiful.
